Data on International Students in Higher Education – Explanatory Note

The Department of Education collects data on international students under the Education Services for Overseas Students Act 2000 (ESOS Act) and the Higher Education Support Act 2003 (HESA). Consequently the department has two data sources relating to international students in the higher education sector. This is a summary of the main similarities and differences.
