- ◆ Tasmania recorded 3,646 international student enrolments and 2,013 commencements from students on a student visa in 2005 – increase of 11.1% and 8.8% respectively on 2004.
- ◆ Tasmania has a 1.1% share of total international student enrolments on a student visa in Australia.
- ◆ Most enrolments continue to be in higher education (1,903 – 52% of total Tasmanian enrolments), with a recorded growth of 17.6% on 2004.
- ◆ Highest enrolment growth was in the Higher Education sector (17.6% on 2004), followed by the ELICOS sector (14.1% on 2004). The largest increase in commencements was in the Higher education sector (25.1%) followed by Schools (13.4%). All other sectors experienced negative growth
- ◆ Largest source nationalities of enrolments were China (23% of total), Malaysia (20%) and South Korea (9%).
