- ◆ The Northern Territory recorded 413 international student enrolments and 246 commencements from students on a student visa in 2005 an increase of 0.5% and 25.5% on 2004 respectively.
- ♦ The NT has a 0.1% share of total international student enrolments on a student visa in Australia.
- ♦ Most enrolments are in higher education (162) 39% of total NT enrolments, with a recorded growth of 4.5% on 2004.
- ◆ Highest growth in both enrolments and commencements was in the ELICOS sector (86.4% and 122.2% on 2004), followed by the Higher Education sector (4.5% and 69.0%).
- ♦ Largest source nationalities of enrolments were Indonesia, China and Philippines.
